



Abraham Chatty Chapman

November 24, 1926 - April 19, 2014

Abraham Chapman (Chatty) was born on November 24, 1926 in Homestead, Pennsylvania. He was 1 of 9 children from the union of the late James and Ida Chapman. James and his siblings were raised in Homestead and he was educated in the Homestead Public School System and was a 1944 graduate of Homestead Senior High School.

After high school, like many of the men of his generation, Chatty entered the United States Army. During the majority of his tour of duty, he worked as a mail handler on the railroad. Upon his honorable discharge he returned to Homestead where among his siblings, family, and childhood friends he would become a lifelong resident.

Chatty was united in marriage to the late Margaret Bell Chapman and together they would raise their 5 children. In his later years he was married a second time to the late Joyce Brooks Chapman. There were no children from this union.

Chatty went to work for the United States Postal Service and remained in their employ for his entire work career; retiring with over 39 years of loyal service. Over the years he worked at a number of postal sites and was well liked and held in high regard by his fellow coworkers.

In his retirement he had time to enjoy his role as grandfather, play cards with friends, and go to the horse races. He also loved watching his favorite NBA team, The Miami Heat, on television.

On Saturday, April 19, 2014 Abraham Chapman departed this life. He is preceded in death by his children: Reginald, Glenn, Janet, Elaine, and grandson, Craig Rhodes, Jr.

He leaves to cherish his memory, son, Dale(Rebecca)Chapman; 6 grandchildren; great grandchildren; nieces and nephews; other relatives and good friends too numerous to mention.
