You loved to watch television and knew when your favorite programs would be on: The Wheel of Fortune, the soap operas, the cooking shows, and especially the news. After the 11:00 o'clock news you would turn off the television and announce, "it's time for bed." You wouldn't go to sleep but would sit up with your legs crossed like an indian with a box in front of you. Sometimes that is how you would sleep. You slowed down when you turned sixty. Your vision, hearing and comprehension declined. To the family you were a miracle child. The doctors told us that you would not live past your teens. You fooled everyone by outliving our parents, your sisters: Estelle, Lois, and Marion and brother, Richard. Your strong will and stubbornness kept you here! Bev, you were four days short of your sixty-second birthday and just like I held you as a baby, I held you in my arms when you took your last breath. You will be sadly missed by me, and your brother Raymond; 12 nieces, 1 nephew, 19 great nieces and nephews, 20 great great nieces and nephews and other family and friends who are saddened at your passing.

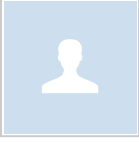
