



## Charles "Buddy" Law

Charles D. Law, Jr. was born on May 5, 1930, in McKeesport, Pennsylvania. He was the son of The late Eleanor V. Staley and Charles D. Law, Sr. "Buddy" as he

was called by family and friends alike, was educated in the McKeesport School

District where he was a 1948 graduate of McKeesport Senior High School. In his

youth he and his siblings attended the Bethlehem Baptist Church. Shortly after graduation, Buddy enlisted in the United States Army where he proudly served during the Korean Conflict spending a significant portion of his 8 year tour in Hawaii. Buddy was one of the first minorities hired at that plant and he retired

with over 30 years of continuous and dedicated service.

Buddy loved sports and always made it a point to attend his children and grand childrens 'games or any activity that they were involved in. He was a

for the McKeesport Little League and an avid Pittsburgh Pirate and Pittsburgh Steeler

fan. Also, in retirement he enjoyed working in his tool room, playing cards, watching old movies, especially westerns, and he loved miniature trains, the Buddy-L in particular.

He was a member of the American Legion Post 666 and a founding member of

The Esquire Club. Buddy always enjoyed the company of others and he had a wicked

sense of humor.
