*He enlisted in the United States Army in 1957 and was discharged in 1960 with the Good Conduct Medal and an Army Of Occupation Medal in Berlin. He worked at United State Steel as a truck driver and Workingman's Club as President for many years.

*He was united in marriage to Nancy Madison on August 19, 1956 and they were blessed with a daughter, Donna Elizabeth.

*He was a jack of all trades. You could count on him to repair anything. He was a mentor to all his nieces, nephews and neighbors, even if they accepted his wisdom or not. He loved to garden and watch sports in person or on TV. He was also a devoted and humbled servant of God. He was baptised and became a new member of Park Place African Methodist Episcopal Church on a Sunday in October of 2002. He was a Senior Usher and one of the church's Financial Leaders.

*Three times on the night before his death my dad told me and my cousin Monique he had "Decisions To Make". After his discussions with GOD he chose death over life on his terms.

*My dad was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, siblings, in-laws son in-law and nieces and nephews.

*He leaves to honor and cherish his memory his daughter, Donna E. Jones, his grandson, Antonio Donald Jones, his great granddaughter, Arianna Jones and his dog, Apple Waller. He is survived by his brother Merle (Janelle) Waller and Gertrude Warren, sister-in-law.
