Fannie Bell (Searcy) Jackson, a/k/a Little Sis, was born in Shiloh, Georgia, to Willie and Sallie Mae Searcy on September 18, 1923, and was the fourth child of twelve brothers and sisters. Fannie, along with her family, moved to Etowah County in Birmingham, Alabama. At the age of twenty-one she moved to Pittsburgh, PA, assisting her cousin who was ill, after which she decided to stay. Her first job was at Kaufmann's as a waitress, then she was employed as a steamer, she sought gainful employment at Federal Enamel which was located in McKeesport, PA.

At age thirty-three she met and married Lonnie Lee Jackson on January 13, 1957, who preceded her in death in 1988. Of that union four children were born, Valerie (Jackson) James, Lonett Jackson, Faynell, and William Jackson. 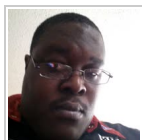

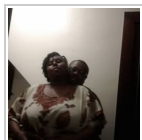
