He went on to preside over weddings, officiate numerous homegoing services and give countless sermons.

When someone thinks of Greg some big things that come to mind are fishing, cooking, his children and that you can rely on him in a bind. His kids would sometimes come home to “Gone Fishing” notes left on the table. He loved the

peace fishing gave him, the time spent with his fishing buddies and the ability to teach and pass it onto his grandchildren. Not only did he feed his family from fishing, but he was known for his abilities in the kitchen & on the grill. Greg had constant requests for things like his ribs, pound cakes, salmon Pattie's, and sweet potato pies. Greg lived for his children, there wasn't anything he didn't do from plaits & barrettes before school, advice, car maintenance and basically creating Pap Pap's daycare. Not only was he always there for his children & grandchildren, but he took his role serious as the eldest brother and he was the "go to" for many in their time of need, never just doing the bare minimum.

Greg's spirit was called home to God on September 5, 2022 after battling various health issues for many years. He was surpassed by his father Mickey, mother Edith, sister Rose Heflin and son Jeremiah Scales. Gregory leaves to cherish his memory and mourn his passing, sons Gregory, Garrett, daughters Sofia, Sharisa, Sara, Sippora, Shiprah Scales, brothers Theodore (Isis), Kenneth & Arthur Scales, sisters Caroline (Omar) Marsh, Edith and Joyce Scales, fifteen grandchildren, one great grandchild and a wealth of aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews and friends.
