



## Henry Arnold Arrington

August 27, 1946 - October 23, 2015

Henry Arnold Arrington was born on August 27, 1946 in West Mifflin, Pennsylvania. He was the fourth child and eldest son of Ida Mae Durant Arrington and Henry Arrington. As the eldest son, Henry, or Arnold, felt responsibility to protect his siblings and he had a very close and loving relationship with his younger brother, Norman "Nootie" Arrington, who died at age 19. As a very young man, Henry joined Morning Star Baptist Church, West Mifflin. He attended West Mifflin Area Schools, and those who knew him then may remember his beautiful "broadcaster" voice and his athletic ability. For years, Arnold held a track record at West Mifflin High School and his baritone voice landed him a role in his high school musical "South Pacific". Upon graduation from high school, Henry enlisted in the United States Air Forces. There he was trained as an electrician, and he utilized that specialized training at the United States Steel Irvin Works in Dravosburg, where he was employed at many years as an electrician in the Hot Mill. Henry had struggled with alcohol addiction, but was very proud of the fact that he had been sober for 17 years and that for many of those years has served as the facilitator at his local AA meetings.

Henry Arnold Arrington viewed all of life's situations with rare optimism. He was an honorable and generous man who dearly loved his family and liked to mentor the young. He is cherished and lovingly remembered by his children: Mr. Norman (Marquita) Carter, Mr. Eugene Carter and Ms. Shanelle Arrington; a special longtime friend and companion, Ms. Catrina Johnson; two sisters,

Dr. Elayne Arrington and Mrs. Katherine Arrington Taylor; a special aunt, Mrs. Ruth Allen; 20 grandchildren, 2 great grandchildren; and a host of other relatives and friends.
