Nancy Reba Yarbough Wiggins, the daughter of the late Clarence (Bo) Yarbough and Lorraine (Bootsie) Harris Yarbough Pryor, was born April 8, 1937, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Nancy was educated in the Pittsburgh Public Schools system and attended Burgwin Elementary School and Gladstone High School.
