Oscar W. Underwood, Jr. was born May 9, 1948 in Braddock, PA. He was the son of Lucille Webster and the late Oscar W. Undersood, Sr. "Pye", as he was called by family and friends alike, grew up in the community of Duquesne where he attended Trinity Church of God in Christ and was educated in the Duquesne Public School System. It was during the Viet Nam War conflict that Oscar answered the call to duty and enlisted in the United States Marine Corps. He received a number of awards and commendations before his honorable discharge.

On July 3, 1974 Oscar was united in marriage to Thelma Gussie Harper and from this union 3 sons were born. A second marriage to Gwen Hardaway produced 1 son; but fate would have it he later remarried the love of his life. Gussie.

Before retiring with over 20 ears of loyal and dedicated service, Oscar was employed as a professional chauffeur with the Regency Limousine Service. He absolutely loved his job and the list of clientele who specifically requested his services included celebrities: Michael Jordan, B.B. King, Jamie Lee Curtis, Pittsburgh Steeler president, Dan Rooney and many members and players in the Steeler organization. His popularity and dedication earned him the title of "2002 Chauffeur Of The Year".

Oscar loved cars and model trains, music, and was a Pittsburgh Steeler Fan. His family was very dear to his heart as was his love for the Marine Corps. and its military discipline. He was near to a fault! Everything had to be in its place all the time.

On March 11, 2017, Oscar W. Underwood, Jr. departed this life. He is preceded in death by his father, Oscar W. Underwood, Sr. and a brother, Clayton Worthy.

He leaves to honor and cherish his memory beloved wife, Thelma G. Underwood; mother, Lucille Underwood; 6 sons: Lamontae, Javon, Daniel, Elton, Toby, and Chad Underwood; siblings: Larry (Verna) Underwood, Stephanie Diane Underwood Tyson, Anthony Underwood, Derrick Underwood, Dennis Baker, and Gregory Lane; favorite uncle, Gregory Webster and uncle, Doug Webster; 6 grandchildren; nieces, nephews, and friends too numerous to mention.
