Pearl E. Bundrige was born January 15, 1931, in Homestead, PA, to Mattie Jordan and Coleman Ellis. Pearl was born in Homestead, PA and raised in Glen Hazel. She was educated in the Pittsburgh Public School System, graduating from Alderdice High School.

*Pearl was part of a close-knit community of friends in Glen Hazel. She loved to play bid-whist, 500, and pinochle with her friends. As one of her favorite pastimes, she orchestrated many bus trips to Seven Springs, various cities and casinos. She was an avid traveler both in the States and abroad.
