Rosetta Cornelious was born on June 23, 1931, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. She was the daughter of the late Burleigh and Estee Patterson Cornelious. She spent her early years in Duquesne, PA before her father gained employment with Jones & Laughlin Steel in Hazelwood and the family relocated close by to the Glen Hazel Housing Development. "Polly", as she was always called by family and friends alike, and her siblings grew up in this closeknit community. In her youth she attended the Second Baptist Church in Homestead under the pastorate of the late Rev. J.D. Morton. She was educated in the Pittsburgh Public School System and graduated from Gladstone High School.

She worked for a time at the Jewish Home in Squirrel Hill, but for the greater part of her working life she worked for private families. She loved them dearly and everything that she did was for their well being; but she was also caring and welcoming to everyone that she knew. She absolutely had a heart of gold. She loved to cook and bake in addition to making the best potato salad and enjoying

a good game of bingo.

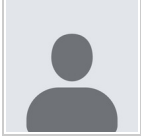
