



## Shirley A. McCutcheon

Shirley Ann McCutcheon, or “Mac”, as she was affectionately known, was born on February 15, 1940, in Pittsburgh, PA, the only child of the union of James and Eva McCutcheon (Summers), and the beloved step-daughter of Albert W. Davis.
