“ During the last 8 years of my Postal career, I met Vanessa when she and I became coworkers, first in Timekeeping, then in Human Resources. We became friends. Having a friend nearby made our workloads lighter and the workday shorter.

Vanessa was always in tip-top shape and she always looked great. Sometimes we went for walks during our lunch break. Although she was wearing high heels and I was in low heels, I could barely keep up with her. I would be worn out while she seemed to be just catching her stride.

Sometimes our co-workers would complain that her high heels were against safety regulations. She would remind them that rule only applied to the work floor. We knew they were really jealous of her style and beauty. We would look at each other, tilt our heads with expressions like “do you believe that” and laugh.

We discussed important events in our personal lives. Whenever either of us had something weighing heavy on our hearts, Vanessa’s first response was that we should pray. When I shared my troubles, she would lead us in beautiful prayers, she always knew what to say. Afterward, I always felt much better having taken her advice and shifted my burden to the Lord.

After retiring we kept in touch at least three times each year enjoying long conversations catching up on whatever happened in the six months between our birthdays. In between those months we also shared a group text with our mutual co-worker and friend, on his birthday.

Last year on her birthday she told me the devastating news about her condition. I was extremely concerned so I began checking on her more often. Our last communication was on February 14. She answered my text replying she was okay and hoped I was too. This made news of her passing the following week a terrible shock, a sadness that I didn’t want to believe.

Vanessa is one of the rare people whom I can't imagine that anyone would say anything about her that wasn't good. She was kind, understanding, and grounded in faith.

It is my honor to call her my friend—a great friend. I know her greatest joys were her family, and I pray that her family finds comfort in each other and in the Lord.
