It was a coal mining town and times were sometimes hard, but it was a good life. Serving the Lord, Jesus Christ was always a central part of her home, and at the age of 6 she became a member of the family church, Mt. Zion Church in Grindstone, PA.

Vivian was educated at Redstone High School, shortly thereafter, met the love of her life, Edgar Thomas Robinson, Sr. Edgar and Vivian were married on January 31, 1948 and moved to Pittsburgh in the summer of 1948. In December 1971, Vivian and Edgar moved to Homestead, PA, where she resided for the remainder of her life.

Vivian was employed at Prizant Carpet and then did house cleaning for homes in the Squirrel Hill area, but family was her central focus. Her marriage to Edgar was blessed with four children, JoAnn, Edgar Jr., Donna and Marvin. They were her joy and she committed herself to caring for and raising them. Vivian's love was not showered just on her immediate family, but she continued to give loving care to her parents in their senior years and as their health became frail.
